**Minutes of Board Meeting October 24, 2006**

The meeting was called to order at 7:20 PM. Location: the Rayhrer residence.

**SECRETARY:**

Jim Peet advised that the deadline for an up-dated membership list for the Nachrichten editor should be November 1, not December 1. Alicia McVicker moved the Minutes be approved as amended; Benno Rayhrer seconded; MSP

**TREASURER:**

Benno Rayhrer has distributed the September report; we had income of \$835 in membership dues and a \$20 donation from Fred Yamashita. Norbert pointed out expenses are less than usual.

Sandra Knapp moved the Treasurer's Report be accepted as submitted; Jim Peet seconds; MSP.

**V.P. SPECIAL:**

**V.P. SOCIAL:**

Dina Buhler explained that she has changed arrangements for the Holiday Party; the 6:30 to 7:30 no-host bar will include wine; dinner wine will be provided by the club (\$5 per bottle corkage) and limited to approximately 2 glasses per person; any leftover will be served at the bar during entertainment. Dina moved we cancel the Holiday Party fee motion made in September; Louis Buhler seconds; MSP. Dina moves that we charge \$35 for members and \$45 for non-members for the Holiday Party; Louis Buhler seconds; MSP. Dina moves the Club charge \$10 additional per person for reservations received after December 11; Louis seconds; MSP.
